- Follow race organiser's number transfer rules and guidelines, when advertising race numbers you are unable to use and wish to pass on to another runner.
- Demonstrate respect towards fellow athletes, acting with dignity and display courtesy and good manners towards others
- In no way undermine, put down or belittle other athletes, coaches
- Follow the <u>rules for use of Hoad Hill Harriers Facebook Page</u> which are in place to ensure nothing inappropriate is posted or puts the club into disrepute

Breaches of these, may result in verbal, written warnings and ultimately may require the member to leave the club.
